Xtra Time and 1st Touch Coaching will:

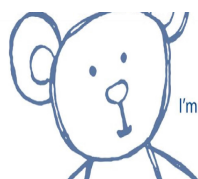
- Provide a caring environment where the children can learn, play and develop their full potential.

Admission Arrangements

The admission arrangement makes no distinction between children identified as having special needs and those not so identified.
